Income Guidelines

60% Estimated State Median Income Levels

To be eligible, household must have a total gross income of no more than:

Who is Eligible?

Household must meet the following requirements:

1. Have a total household gross income of no more than 60% of the Federal Poverty guidelines.

2. Be a resident of Natchitoches Parish.

Additional requirements may be necessary to determine eligibility

How to Apply?

Applications are accepted by appointment. When applying for assistance, you must bring:

1. Government issued Photo ID of all household members over 18 years of age
2. Social Security cards for all household members
3. Proof of income for the past 30 calendar days for all household members
4. Utility Bills for Heating and Cooling no older than 30 days
5. Food Stamp Approval Letter (if receiving)
6. Proof of present address (rent receipt, lease, or deed, etc.)

Additional information may be required to determine your eligibility for energy assistance

The Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) is a federally funded program that provides energy assistance payments to low-income households. First come, first serve eligibility requirements apply.
