TAKEN A REGULAR MEETING HELD, MONDAY,

March 19, 2018

5:30 p.m.

The Natchitoches Parish Council met in regular and legal session in the Council Board Room of the Natchitoches Parish Courthouse, on Monday, March 19, 2018 for a Regular of Natchitoches Parish Council meeting at five(5:30) o'clock p.m. and for the Natchitoches Parish Council Meeting.

The Parish of Natchitoches was then convened as the governing authority by Chairman Rodney Bedgood who stated that the Parish was ready for the transaction of business.

The invocation was given by Mr. Billy Shugart and the Pledge of Allegiance led by Councilman Chris Paige.

After the roll call there were present Chairman Rodney Bedgood and Council: Doug de Graffenried, Russell Rachal, Chris Paige, and Patsy Ward-Hoover.

Absent: None.

Chairman, Bedgood stated the next agenda item we will hear the report of the Public Works Interim Director, Mr. Earl Townsend. Mr. Townsend had already sent his reports and asked were there any questions or comments. No questions or comments.

Chairman, Bedgood, then recognizes Ms. Sharon Harris, OCS/Head Start Executive Director, she gave her reports in the Council's packets and wanted to know if they had any questions, comments or concerns on the reports. Councilwoman, Hoover said she would like to meet with Ms. Harris later to discuss a matter.

Chairman, Bedgood, then recognizes Parish Treasurer Debbie Miley She mail all the reports in the Council packages, and reports for Head Start, Credit Card transactions, all checked written.

Councilman, Chris Paige had a question for Ms. Debbie Miley, He wanted to know, Who hired the Gold Law Firm and how much was paid to them as of this date? Ms. Miley, responded, "Mr. Paige, I don't know that off the top of my head, I apologize, but I have no idea, but I believe we've paid two invoices." Councilman, Paige continued to say that some Council members were sure you knew that money was being paid to this law firm, Have we visited that measure and I went to sleep at the meeting or something? I don't remember we voted to approve this or not or if we didn't have to do that, who ever can spend whatever."

Councilwoman, Hoover, responded, "I only can speak for myself Mr. Paige, I didn't know anything about hiring a lawyer, maybe our President can answer that question."

Parish President, Nowlin, responded, "The Gold Law firm is handling a couple of lawsuits for the Parish which was filed by a couple of past employees. To my understanding these types of expenditures are covered by the Budget and the Charter, if it's not Ms. Miley and the ADA can correct me, but I think it will be good at the next meeting to have an Executive Session to review those things in details and to bring you up to date on the status of those litigation's, they're still in the discovery phase, but this needs to be discussed in an Executive Session.

Councilwoman, Hoover, responded, by saying, "I appreciate what you're saying, but I'm like Mr. Paige, if an attorney is hired, I think the

Council should have been notified, Why they was hired and who they was hired by, I think this has disrespected this Council and this is the taxpayers money." At this time, Councilman Paige continued to talk about the \$600.00 and some dollars, he said he would rather someone tell him about it, than turn through a book of papers to see it, I feel that if money is spent the Council should be brought in to know about it and decide whether we want to or not."

Chairman, Bedgood then recognizes Parish President, Parish President wanted to go over a couple of items on his report.

BUILDING MAINTENANCE:

a. Live Oak Building Roof: The construction contract has been awarded to Terry's Roofing and Sheet Metal, in the amount of \$74,000. The contractor is to begin work on March 19th, weather permitting.

ADA COMPLIANCE:

a. HC Ramp at Main Entrance: According to Mr. Minturn, the project construction will be advertised on February 22, 2018. Bids will be opened on March 29, 2018.

PARISH PERSONNEL:

Public Works Director: No offer of employment has been extended to any of the candidates for the position. The position will be re-advertised.

CAPITAL PROJECTS:

a. Coco Bed Road Improvements: The Final revisions to the project specifications are nearly complete. Following their submission to Facility Planning and Control receipt of FP&C approval, the project will be advertise for bids.

The Parish submitted a proposal for a storm water drainage project during two days of meetings in Alexandria about a year ago. The project would improve drainage from Keyser Avenue near Blanchard Subdivision eastward to the Red River. Recently we were notified that our proposal was one of three selected in north Louisiana for further study. The first step is the preparation of a hydraulic and hydrology study. LSU has been successful in obtaining the assistance of U.S. EPA and the American Geophysical Union who will perform the study at no cost to the Parish. After the study has been completed, the Parish and LSU will seek project funding assistance from various federal and state agencies.

Councilman, Rachal asked a question to Parish President, Nowlin, "Concerning the Concrete Barriers that DOTD was offering to donate to the Parish for the shooting range, wondering, have you heard back from them?", the President, replied, "No, Sir, I haven't heard back from them, but I'll make a note to contact them."

Chairman, Bedgood then stated the next agenda item is to adopt the minutes of the regular meeting of the Natchitoches Parish Council held Tuesday, February 20, 2018.

Chairman, Bedgood stated the next agenda Item is First Introduction of Proposed Ordinances.

First Introduction of proposed Ordinances.

Introduction of Ordinance 002-2018 for Budget Revisions to the 2018 Operating Budget to the General Fund, Highway Department, Solid Waste, Sales Tax, Hampton Road, and Coco Bed Road.

Parish Treasurer, Debbie Miley gave a brief summary on what was needing to be revised in the Budget for this funds. Coco Bed need to bring over some more money and Hampton Road didn't have a budget had to bring in a budget for Hampton Road. and looking at a new building for Solid Waste.

Councilman, Paige wanted to know what happened to Payne Subdivision? Last year it was Coco Bed and Payne Subdivision. Ms. Miley, responded, "We still have a budget for Payne Subdivision." Councilman, Paige went on to say, "There is shifting of the priorities and money and this is becoming a problem with me, and when we can discuss this matter, please let me know exactly what's going on." At this time the Parish Attorney said she object to this, that Ms. Miley doesn't know the information, that's being asked, and maybe the Parish President has the information." Councilman, Paige, responded, "I like, I said in the beginning, if this not the time to answer my questions, but when it does come to a public hearing or whatever, I and the Payne Subdivision residents would like to know what's going on."

On motion by Councilman Russell Rachal, duly seconded by Councilwoman Patsy Ward Hoover that the Natchitoches Parish Council, in regular and legal session, does hereby Introduce of Ordinance 002-2018 for Budget Revisions to the 2018 Operating Budget to the General Fund, Highway Department, Solid Waste, Sales Tax, Hampton Road, and Coco Bed Road.

At this time the Parish President begin to speak on the matter concerning Payne Subdivision he said the plans will be submitted to Facility and Planning next month for Payne Subdivision. Councilman, Paige, stated, "Myself and the residents of Payne Subdivision will not have to asked for this information once it's done, you will make this available to us, right?" Parish President, replied, "Yes."

Chairman, Bedgood read the next agenda item

Other Agenda Items:

A. Council to consider to allow another attempt to repair and rehabilitate the Shady Grove Community center or, in view of the current status of the center, to allow it to return to the church.

Parish President gave a brief summary of what was taking place with the Shady Grove Community Center about 2 years ago and now he's asking the Council to revisit the issue to allow the Community more time to

fix up the Center and to be used for a Community Center or to return it back over to the Shady Grove Baptist Church.

At this time Mr. J.W. Scarborough was the spokesperson for the Shady Grove Community. Mr. Scarborough stated that he was asked by the Shady Grove Community Center Board to help to come up with a deal to fix the Community Center. Mr. Scarborough came with a suggestion of taking 30 people and come up with \$200.00 each to put a brand new top on the building to keep it from leaking and after that we'll do the inside and we'll get a contract signed before we get someone to work on it and the community residents is going to buy the material and we'll raise at least \$6,000.00 to do this and if we'll need more we'll do it. The board voted 3 different times to do that.

Mr. Scarborough stated, that if the residents of the Community are going to do the repairs they want it in their names. He's asking that the Parish Council turns it to the Community and not the church. So it will be in the Community name.

Councilman, Paige asked the question, "I remember in the past from one of the members of the Church. The church owns part of the land and the Community Center is owning a separate part. Now if this is something we have to vote on tonight, Have both groups came to an agreement?" Mr. Scarborough, responded, "You have the church and you have the Board of Directors, which some of them are members of the church, not all of them, but the majority of them, so they asked me to come and my commitment is that we will raise the money and put a brand new top on it and remodel the building so they can use it. It's for the Community, not for the church. If we spend money on it, we'll going to spend it on something we own, we're not going to spend money on someone's else property. You have a big problem with roads and this is a big liability that can be taken off your hands, if you release it back to the Community, otherwise if it's not release back to the community, I can't see us spending money on it." Councilman, Paige, still stated, "I think it's the best thing to do to see if it's clarified with the church members I feel that we should make sure this is together before we go into a vote on this, we need to know where everyone stands on this before we vote. You have separate views out there concerning this matter, we just need to have clarity and no disrespect to you on this." Councilman, Rachal asked, Mr. Scarborough if we should vote for you to get this center, what time frame are you looking at to get this done?" Mr. Scarborough, replied, "We first was going to do it in February, and then I talked with Mr. Nowlin, and he said to bring it up this month, and I gave the residents to the end of April to have their \$200.00, so we have from April to June to get this done, because the Shady Grove Reunion will be starting in July. I think within those 3 months we can have a top and work in the inside."

At this time, Councilwoman, Hoover wanted to make a motion to table this until next month so we can have all parties involved and we can see what both sides says to this.

The Parish Attorney read some of the original contract and it stated if the Parish doesn't use it as a Community Center then the title will be reinvested back to the Church and she'll research this further, but the Parish can not sell or give it to any parties except back to the Church.

Parish President stated, "The Parish Attorney was reading from an opinion that was given through the District Attorney's Office and he feels Mrs. Hoover has a point to table this until next month. It probably would be best for the DA's Office, Mr. Scarborough, a Church representative, and myself sit down and figure this out."

Mr. Scarborough stated, "My last words is if the Council looks back on this and it's reverting back to the church, my words and my stand, the church repair it. If it's reverting back to the community, we will raise the money and we will repair it and have it ready. That's my stand on it and I'll be willing to meet with you."

On motion by Councilwoman Patsy Ward Hoover, duly seconded by Councilman Russell Rachal that the Natchitoches Parish Council, in regular and legal session, does hereby table consider to allow another attempt to repair and rehabilitate the Shady Grove Community center or, in view of the current status of the center, to allow it to return to the church.

If these aren't rolled forward we can never get the maximum of 3.47 or 1.73 we'll only going to be able to stay at the 3.39 and 1.69. (These are not for the other taxes that was voted for on the ballot such as Library, Health Unit, and Road District 40, etc.) This is only for the above two. There was discussion from the Council members and the residents and the Parish Attorney. This was a lengthy discussion. After all the discussion the following was done:

Chairman, Bedgood read the next agenda item.

Council to consider to receive information from interested persons regarding whether said persons are for or against keeping the Home Rule charter and Council-President form of government. And to vote by motion to consider an Introduction Ordinance proposed by a referendum to the voters of Natchitoches Parish, during the November 6, 2018 Open Primary/Congressional elections, in the form of a question as to the pleasure of the voters of Natchitoches Parish in regard to continuing to utilize the Home Rule Charter Council-President form of government or repeal the same and replace it with the Police Jury form of government.

At this time Councilman, Paige wanted to do away with the 3 minutes rule and let the people have time to say what they have come to say.

Parish Attorney told Mr. Paige "I reviewed the Ordinance and the Ordinance doesn't allow to suspend the rule and I've been educated by Mr. de Graffenried that Robert Rule of Order states unless the Ordinance allows or states the rules to be suspended then it cannot be suspended, the 3 minutes time limits has to stand." Chairman, Bedgood, at this time said he wants everyone to speak but they must follow the rules. If it's 3 minutes then, they need to only speak for 3 minutes, so everyone would have time to speak. Councilman, Rachal, replied, "It cost me a \$1,000 for this same thing, and we're going to go by the rules tonight." A resident from Ashland wanted to let the Council know that the people need more time to talk, and she told Councilman, Rachal she wasn't threatening him, but that \$1,000 he spent will be well worth it, because he will come up for vote again.

Mr. David Lewis and Mr. Robert Jackson, Sr. were to speak on the concerns to change the form of Government. Mr. David Lewis is requesting the Council to give the people the opportunity to vote if they still want to continue with the Parish Government-Home Rule Charter type of government. Mr. Lewis gave a Proposal for the Council to vote on. It reads as: Propose a referendum to the voters of Natchitoches Parish, during the November 6, 2018 Open Primary/Congressional elections, in the form of a question as to the pleasure of the voters of Natchitoches Parish in regard to continuing to utilize the Home Rule Charter Council-President form of government or repeal the same and replace it with the Police Jury form of government. The ballot form for the referendum on this proposed question shall be:

"Shall the Home Rule Charter Council-President form of government for Natchitoches Parish be repealed and replaced with the Police Jury form of government having 11 representative districts coincidental with the Natchitoches Parish School Board districts, in accordance with the Constitution of Louisiana and other applicable law?"

Many residents spoke on why they feel it should go back to the Police Jury Form of Government and they made it known. One resident wanted to know where they are going to get the money from if they do go back. The majority that was present wasn't pleased with the Home Rule Charter form of Government. The people asked the Council to let them know who was for or who was against. 3 Councilmen said they were for going back and 2 Councilmen said, No. At this time, Councilman de Graffenried and Councilman Rachal spoke about the reasons why they weren't going to support the Police Jury form of Government they gave a brief overview of things that happened in the past with the Police Jury form of government. The residents kept interrupting not wanting to hear what they had to say, Parish President, Rick Nowlin also spoke about the Police Jury form of Government, but at this time no one was listening and a motion was called to adjourn, because since there wasn't a 2/3 vote there wasn't really nothing that could have been done.

Chairman, Bedgood read the next agenda item to Adjourn.





WHEREAS, in accordance with Article V, Section 5-04 (A - F) Amendments to the Operating Budgets of the Natchitoches Parish Home Rule Charter, the council is authorized to amend the budget as required by law when there are funds available for appropriation in excess of those estimated in the operating budget and there is a reduction of appropriations, and

WHEREAS, the Parish President has certified that there are funds available for appropriation in excess of those estimated in the operating budget and has determined that there will be insufficient funds available to meet the amount appropriated for some, and

WHEREAS, based on this information the Parish Council has determined that it is necessary to amend the 2016 operating budget, in accordance with the Parish Home Rule Charter and state law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Natchitoches Parish Council, in regular and legal session convened, does hereby amend the Parish 2017 Operating Budget.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the President is hereby authorized to take all actions necessary to implement the terms and conditions of this Ordinance.
